The Health Fair is being organized out of a concern for the devastating effect that high blood pressure can have on life and limb. *"High Blood Pressure (HBP) can be dangerous, even fatal, without presenting recognizable symptoms."*

Free blood pressure screenings and literature pertaining to nutrition, exercise and other health care concerns will be provided to all attendees at the fair. As an added attraction, each person checking their blood pressure will receive a raffle ticket which will give him or her a chance to win prizes such as two round trip airline tickets to Guyana and a weekend for two at the Princess Hotel in Providence, East Bank Demerara, comprehensive physical examinations, gym memberships or other consolation prizes.
